



I am directed to invite your attention to the subject cited above and to say that vide even U.O. No. dated 21.12.2018, the State Government had decided that wherever the Administrative Departments/Boards/Corporations/Autonomous Units are regularizing persons under the regularization policies dated 17.6.1997, 5.11.1999, 1.10.2003 and 10.2.2004, the Administrative Departments, with approval of Finance Department, may create some posts of diminishing nature to adjust such employees.

Now, Learned Advocate General, Haryana has brought to the notice of State Government that vide interim order dated 25.1.2019 in LPA No. 109 of 2019 (O&M) titled as "State of Haryana & others Vs. Balwinder Singh & others passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of Punjab & Haryana High Court has stayed the order dated 4.10.2018 passed by the Hon'ble Single Bench of Punjab & Haryana High Court in CWP No. 2009 of 2016 titled as "Balwinder Singh & others Vs. State of Haryana & others regarding regularization of employees.

Therefore, you are requested to file Appeals against the regularization orders if any passed by the Single Bench of Hon'ble High Court relating to employees of your department.

It is reiterated that cases of the employees for regularization are required to be considered as per final direction of the Hon'ble Division Bench of High Court.
